IGETC: OPTION 3

2021-2022 INTERSEGMENTAL GENERAL EDUCATION TRANSFER CURRICULUM

In spring 2008, Orange Coast College converted to a new database as part of the Coast Community College District. As a result, a "C" was added to all the course numbers (i.e., ENGL 100 changed to ENGL A100). The official transcript will show the "C" p course number for all courses since 1989, even though the actual change did not occur until spring 2008.

Completion of the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) will satisfy the lower division general education requirements of either the California State University or University of California system. The IGETC should be completed prior to transferring or the student may be subject to the general education requirements of the campus to which they have been admitted.

All courses must be completed with grades of "C" or better. Grades of "pass" may be used if "pass" is equal to a "C" or better, but be aware that there are limits to the number of units that can be taken P/NP. Courses used to meet IGETC requirements must be at least 3 semester units or 4 quarter units.

WHAT IS CERTIFICATION?

Certification is the process whereby the completion of the IGETC for students who are transferring to either UC or CSU. This means that students will not have to take any additional lower division General Education courses after transfer. Students who do not have to meet the GE requirements of the specific UC or CSU campus they are transferring to. Doing this usually requires taking a course at the final transfer campus. Certification is not automatic and must be requested in the Records Office when the final transfer campus is a CSU.

MAY COURSES COMPLETED AT OTHER CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY COLLEGES BE USED TO MEET THE IGETC REQUIREMENTS?

Yes. A course completed at any California community college can be used if the course is on that college's approved IGETC list. A course completed at another California community college will be applied in the IGETC area listed by that college. The course must have been on that college's list when the course was taken there.

MAY COURSES TAKEN AT OTHER THAN CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY COLLEGES BE USED TO MEET THE IGETC REQUIREMENTS?

Yes. A course taken at other than a California community college (i.e. UC, CSU, or state college) will be certified if an equivalent course is on the IGETC list. A course taken at any of the California community colleges and the course was approved on the IGETC list when the course was taken at that college.

CAN ALL COURSES ON THE CURRENT IGETC LIST BE USED TO MEET REQUIREMENTS?

Courses on the IGETC list are approved for a specific academic year which begins with the Fall semester. Students wishing to use a course to meet an IGETC requirement must make sure that it is on the list when taken. Courses which have been added to the list since its publication in 1991 are identified in parentheses.
